- Two copies of plot plan (8.5" x 11")** showing proposed fence and required information below
Please provide a plot plan (can be hand drawn – not to scale) showing the primary structure, property lines, location and name of adjacent street(s) in relation to the property, the dimensions and/or property line setbacks of the proposed fence, (and/or any other existing fences or structures), and show the proposed fence line using "XXXX" marks. See provided example on the second page of this form.
- Please note, approvals typically take 7-14 days. Incomplete or inaccurate applications may cause delays. Please provide as much information as possible to discourage delays.


Guidelines for installing new fences in Miami Township:

- Fences may be no taller than (6) six feet in the side or rear yard of a property.
 - Fences no taller than 42" may be located in the front yard.

(The front yard is typically defined as any property located between the front façade of house and the street).

- Please note that any land existing between fence and end of property line must be maintained by the property owner as required.

Sample Plot Plan



The submitted plot plan must show:

1. The location of the primary structure, existing accessory structures, and the location of any existing fence or proposed fence.
2. The property line setbacks of any proposed fence.
3. Location of any adjacent streets, the names of those streets, and the address of the property and the name of the property owner.
